This Code of Conduct ensures all members act safely and respectfully. **Please keep a copy for reference.**

After completing a probationary period and being accepted by the Committee, members must follow these guidelines:

- Submit a membership application and consent form.
- Pay the membership subscription after probation.
- Pay the session attendance fee.
- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear in the Shed.
- Follow Health & Safety guidelines to prevent accidents or damage.
- Use machinery only after training, guidance, and assessment.
- Respect the Shed's facilities, other members, and their belongings.
- No aggressive language, bullying, or intimidation.
- Share skills and advice with fellow members.
- **Plan** projects and consult a supervisor to complete a Risk and Methods Statement.
- Confirm costing and materials before starting any project.
- No alcohol, drugs, or smoking in or around the Shed.
- Clean up dust, shavings, and waste at the end of each session.
- Return tools and machines to their storage and clean them.
- Record accidents/incidents in the accident book.
- Follow reasonable requests from Session Supervisors—their decisions are final.
- Obey safety signs at all times.

This Code of Conduct will be reviewed by the Committee at least once per annum.
